Basic Parliamentary Procedure



Fundamentals of Parliamentary Law

- 1. Justice and courtesy for all.
- 2. Do only one thing at a time.
- 3. The majority rules.
- 4. The rights the minority must be protected.
- 5. Each proposition is entitled to full and free debate.
- 6. The purpose is to facilitate action, not to obstruct it.
- 7. The desires of an individual must be merged into the desires of the assembly.

PRIVILEGED MOTIONS (highest)

1. Fix a time to adjourn	DL
2. Adjourn (unqualified)	ND
3. Take a recess	DL
4. Question of privilege	IS, NS, ND

4. Question of privilege IS, NS, I

INCIDENTAL MOTIONS

5. (no precedence within group)

To suspend rules	ND, 2/3
To withdraw a motion	NS, ND
To object to consideration*	IS, NS, ND, 2/3
Point of order	IS, NS, ND
Point of inquiry	IS, NS, ND
Appeal decision of Chair	IS, DL
Division of Assembly	IS, NS, ND
Division of a motion	ND

SUBSIDIARY MOTIONS

6. Table	ND
7. Previous Question	ND, 2/3
8. Limit or extend debate	DL, 2/3
9. Postpone to a time	DL
10. Refer to a committee	DL
11. Amend	DL
12. Postpone indefinitely	MMD

MAIN MOTIONS (lowest)

(only ONE on the floor at any time)

13. (a) General(b) Specific

Take from Table ND
Reconsider IS, MMD
Rescind MMD, 2/3

Adjourn (qualified)

DL	Debate Limited to specific action in question.
ND	Not Debatable.

IS May Interrupt a Speaker who has the floor.

NS No Second required.

MMD Main Motion is Debatable.

2/3 A two-thirds majority is required.

 $\ensuremath{^*}$ in order only before debate has begun.
